1 Knai Bang Chatt, Cambodia

A collection of three villas in Kep, one of which, a chunky blue multi-levelled construction, was built by Vann Molyvann, a protege of Le Corbusier. Ultra luxurious, with an infinity pool and thatched pavilion.

2 The Duncan House, US

Frank Lloyd Wright built this Usonian home in Illinois in 1957, but its since been dismantled and moved to Acme, Pennsylvania, though with the original fittings – stone fireplace, patio, wooden kitchen – intact.

3 Lunuganga, Sri Lanka

Over 40 years, Geoffrey Bawa – the island's most famous architect – transformed an abandoned cinnamon and rubber estate near Béntota into this gorgeous home. Light-filled spaces look on to the lake, rice fields, hills and magnificent garden.

4 Ola & Pit, Croatia

Designed and built over 25 years by architect Olivera Götz-Trifkovic and her husband Peter Götz, this Istrian pad near Rovinj has floor to ceiling windows with views of pine trees and the sea, a glass atrium, natural stone walls and a granite bathroom. You stay in the ground floor apartment (sleeps
