Live like the Cambodian Tony Stark., Kep, on Cambodia's southeastern coast, epitomizes a modern-day Ta Prohm. During the 1960s, extravagant Le Corbusier-style homes were popular among <u>Cambodia's</u> social elite here. But following the exodus triggered by the civil war many have been reclaimed by the jungle.

Knai Bang Chatt, on the water's edge, is made up of three beautifully renovated, antique-filled villas housing just 11 rooms, within grounds that include a pool, <u>restaurant</u> and one-room spa.

There's a hushed, reverent, luxury feel while the rustic style keeps things casual.
